To provide sound and video reinforcement to proclaim the Word of God within the building and online. The AV Ministry is an essential ministry in the modern age. With it we have a global reach and those within the walls are able to hear worship and preaching clearly without strain.

Specific Ministry Expectations/Responsibilities

1. Faithfulness to Assigned Time and Place of Service:

- Be in the booth and prepared at least 10 minutes before the service.
- Notify the Worship Team Leader or Pastor if you cannot serve at your scheduled time and assist in finding a replacement if needed. Coverage for the A/V ministry is vital.
- Make necessary preparations for the service. Most importantly, prepare through prayer.
- Attend Worship Rehearsals to help with equipment and check sound

2. Diligence in Preparing the Mics:

- Check Batteries on each mic to be used
- Sound check each mic before service

3. Prepare the Livestream

- Check the software to be sure it is up and running without errors
- Check the sound – during sound check and throughout the service
- Check the cameras
- Check the feed once the stream has begun

4. A Ministry of Helps:

- Make certain the speaker is equipped with his mic
- Check with the speaker ahead of time to see if there will be video played during the presentation
- Start up the projectors when you arrive and check monitors up front to ensure they are on and working properly
- Keep the sound booth clean and orderly
- Coordinate directly with the Worship Leader and Lead Pastor
